

**CITY OF SELMA
WORKSHOP/PRE-COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 5, 2006**

The workshop/pre-Council meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Council chambers. Council members answering roll call were: Avalos, Niswander, Mayor Pro Tem Lujan, and Mayor Tow. Council member Derr was absent.

Also present were City Manager Heusser, City Attorney Hargrove, Police Chief Whiteside, Fire Chief Kestly, Public Works Director Weaver, Recreation and Community Services Director Kirchner, Finance Director Bier, Administrative Services Manager Hull, the press, and interested citizens.

The agenda for this meeting was duly posted in a location visible at all times by the general public seventy-two hours prior to this meeting.

City Manager Heusser introduced to Council the new Selma Enterprise Governmental Reporter. Ms. Jessica Szalay was welcomed by the Council.

PRESENTATION BY S-K-F REGARDING PROPOSED RATE INCREASE: City Manager Heusser presented Mr. David Michel who stepped forward to review for the Council the proposal and reasons why a rate increase is being requested. He stated that the increase would be used for refurbishment and replacement of aging facilities at the treatment plant. He also stated that the proposed rate increase would amount to a \$1.00 per month increase for each residence.

He reported that the issue would be heard on June 8, 2006 at the S-K-F facility.

After various questions by Council and comments from the audience he was thanked for the presentation.
