

**CITY OF SELMA  
WORKSHOP/PRE-COUNCIL MEETING  
JUNE 4, 2007**

The workshop/pre-Council meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Council chambers. Council members answering roll call were: Avalos, Niswander, Mayor Pro Tem Lujan, and Mayor Tow. Council member Derr was absent.

Also present were City Manager Heusser, Assistant City Manager Hull, Police Chief Whiteside, Fire Chief Kestly, Public Works Director Weaver, Recreation and Community Services Director Kirchner, Finance Director Bier, the press, and interested citizens.

The agenda for this meeting was duly posted in a location visible at all times by the general public seventy-two hours prior to this meeting.

**PRESENTATION RE. MAGEC:** City Manager Heusser introduced Fresno County District Attorney Elizabeth Egan who stepped forward to report on the increasing gang problems in the County. She reported that the Multi-Agency Gang Enforcement Consortium (MAGEC) has had numerous successes in combating gang activity but additional help is needed.

A power point presentation was then made and information and statistics on gangs, especially those in Fresno County, was presented.

Fresno County Sheriff Margaret Mims then stepped forward to explain why additional appointees to MAGEC are needed and to ask for an officer from Selma.

Fresno County Area 4 Supervisor Judy Case also stepped forward to ask for an appointee to the consortium.

It was the consensus of Council to continue review of the request and to bring back a recommendation for formal action at a later date. No action was taken.

They were thanked for the presentation.
