Lincoln Park Veteran's Plaza Improvements Continue

American Legion Post #12, the Selma District Chamber of Commerce and the City of Selma continue to work together on improvements to the Lincoln Park Veteran's Plaza. The first of several projects included a Memorial Dedication recognizing the branches of the United States Armed Forces on May 26, 2018.

The next phase of improvements will begin on Monday, November 19 and entail removing trees surrounding the plaza that are continually uplifting and cracking the brick work, cement and electric lines from their roots. Following the removal of the trees, a beautification project will begin to plant shrubbery and smaller trees that will better serve this area and decrease damages to the area, yet provide a very nice background to the plaza. Finally, American Legion Post #12 will work with the City of Selma on the placement of three statues within the plaza that will highlight the efforts and memory of veterans.

Please understand that throughout this project and conclusion, the Christmas tree and Santa's House will remain in the same location within the plaza as they have been for years.
