Process:

1. Residents were asked to comment on areas What We Like About Selma.

3. What Could Be Better was converted into a consolidated list.
4. Residents were then provided three stickers and asked to place next to their priorities. (Pink Sticker was their #1 Priority, Orange #2 Priority and Green #3 Priority).
*Some chose to vote Public Safety Overall Priority, instead of signaling out one area. As you review the list of areas of concern with no votes, some of these fell into an overall category in which residents felt it all is important not just one area. A good example was gang prevention.
