

National Center for Health Statistics City-wide Survey

Fresno County, including portions of the city of Selma, has been selected to participate in the National Health & Nutrition Examination Survey (NHANES), a major study of the health of persons living in the United States. The survey is being conducted by the National Center for Health Statistics, part of the Centers for Disease Control Prevention.

The survey is scheduled to begin **Tuesday, January 23, 2018, and run through March 3, 2018.** Interviewers will be knocking on the doors of over 500 randomly selected households throughout the County, including some in the Selma area, conducting a brief questionnaire at the doorstep in order to obtain demographic information used to identify sample participants in the survey.

The CDC has contacted all the law enforcement officials in the area requesting assistance in assuring the public this is a legitimate, federally funded national effort with significant influence on health policy across the nation. The Selma Police Department is posting this notice to ensure the community is aware of these activities.
